SUNDAY MORNING WORSHIP begins at 10:45.

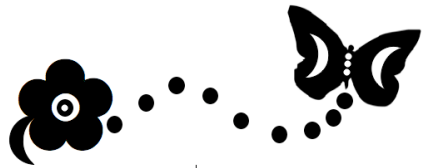
Childcare for children not yet in Kindergarten is provided after Children's Time.
